Mayor's Report (cont.): Received an email from the Department of State regarding plans for the Waterfront projects, they need more information/clarification before they can approve; Wants Board to decide what they want to be strong on for code enforcement, He would like to concentrate on the blight situation, would like to remove the notary requirement from documents that need to be submitted to the Village, Wants committees to look at how codes are being handled; Had been excited about working with the Greater Mohawk Valley Land Bank in the beginning, now sees that 18 Lower Prospect St is up for sale with no improvements done, Looking into a State land bank, May withdrawal from agreement with Greater Mohawk Valley Land Bank

Street & Water Commissioner Report: Keeping up with snow plowing/removal; Working with engineers regarding the materials that they will use for the sanitary project, will be replacing the laterals during the project, suggested using stainless steel curb valves, Engineer is hoping by the end of February to have the specs to the Department of Health for approval and to go out to bid; Talked with Mayor about possibly removing the sidewalk on Montgomery Terrace; Water license is expiring on April 30, 2020, lacking 12 credits, would like approval to take an online course through Rural Water for 10 credits for cost of \$225, Mayor approved.

Mayor Report (cont.): Asked to have the property owners on Montgomery Terrace contacted for their input on removing the sidewalk, would like responses by next board meeting or have them come to the meeting; Would also like to strongly look at hiring an engineer as a village employee for budget purposes, must have all the schooling and licensing; Received revised sample logos for the new website, discussion held and changes suggested by board, Mayor will contact North Shore with suggestions; Thinks the new wattages and inventory for the National Grid LED conversion is straightened out regarding the cobra lights; Clerk and Deputy Clerk's computers have been updated to Windows 10, will bring in the village laptop that he has and have it updated and give to code enforcer to use, would like to buy a desk top computer for the board room; Went to the sewer plant with Trustee Healey and Street & Water Commissioner Weaver to look at possible changes that need to be made for new board meeting room and the clerk's office space.
