First item of business: Discuss COVID19 Guidelines as issued by Gov. Cuomo. Trustee Healey asked about a more permanent instruction sign to be used at the park. Right now, we have poster board. Street and Water Commissioner Weaver replied our regular sign maker (Montgomery Co DPW) is staffed by call ins.

Background Information: CDBG 2016 Joint Grant: Fonda's portion was to address N Center Street reconstruction of water, sanitary and storm. Since so much time has passed from the original grant estimates for this portion of the project, and having gone out to bid twice, with results still over budgeted estimates the situation by Prime Engineers was to move some funding from the NYSEFC WIIA Grant and Loan Program to cover some of the cost. Revised FFJWWTF project provided for additional \$87,186 which was split 50% to each Village (\$43,593), however a shortage remains.
