NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to the resolution duly adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Town of Mohawk Fire District, in the Town of Mohawk, Montgomery County, New York, on January 11, 2021, a Special Referendum at the Special Election of the qualified voters of said Fire District will be held at the Fire Station located at 2553 State Highway 30,4 in the Town of Mohawk, Montgomery County, New York, in said Fire District, on February 23, 2021, at 12:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) and the polls to remain open until 9:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) or as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters then present to cast their votes to vote upon the following Proposition:

PROPOSITION NO. 1
