Meeting Logistics:

Motion by Co-Fiscal Officer Klim to accept the minutes for the January 2, 2023, meeting, Second by Fiscal Officer Walker. Motion passed.

Operational Considerations:

The permitted Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) and Total Suspended Solids (TSS) removal target rates are 85%, set per NYS SPEDES Permit# NY003243. The monthly and year-to-date testing results are represented in the table below:

Green Pines emptied the waste holding tanks hauling the sludge to Gloversville-Johnstown Wastewater Plant. This shall mitigate any possible issues with safe road passage for the remainder of the winter months. The next visit shall be scheduled for late March – early April time frame.

Stephen Miller completed the replacement of the facilities backflow preventer. They are currently compiling estimates for 3 additional projects: 1) Wet Well pump guide rail repair. 2) Waste pump replacement. 3) Sludge pump replacement.

Samples have been sent to Adirondack Environmental Services to perform the required Aquatic Toxicity testing. The fees for this test are approximately \$2000.00.

Mancini Fuels was dispatched to the facility on February 1 to repair the heating (boiler) system.

Chief Cotter is requesting the board investigate purchasing a vehicle for the facility. In support of that, he offered the following scenarios for the proposal: 1) To eliminate the use of personal vehicles while performing official duties. 2) For cleanup of the facility whether snow removal or grounds cleanup. The requested capabilities of said vehicle shall include: 1) Truck with a plow for snow removal, and bed for hauling equipment, brush, etc. Or, 2) Truck with bed for hauling, and a separate snow removal machine, perhaps a tractor with PTO snow thrower attachment. Chairman Park shall reach out to the villages to inquire about the possibility of used equipment for sale.

Finances:

Motion by Co-Fiscal Officer Klim to pay the bills as was discussed and laid out. Second by Co-Fiscal Officer Walker. Motion passed.

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Motion by Co-Fiscal Officer Walker to vote on a resolution for budget transfers. Second by Co-Fiscal Officer Klim. Resolution #1-2023 passed: 4 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Resolution #1-2023 Budget transfers requested for approval.
