The Department of Public Works will resume collecting yard debris and lawn clippings generally **Friday and Monday mornings, or when practical.** Beginning at 7:00 am, the Crew will pass through the Village to pick up contained debris.

We ask that you please **do not** use plastic bags as we want to "go green" with this service. Also, please limit the weight to under 40 lbs. If using a container, please make sure it is covered if there is inclement weather.

Brush and tree limbs must be tied, bundled, less than 4ft in length, and in a pile no larger than 4ft x 4ft x 4ft. If you have an excessive amount or would like to make arrangements for another time, please call 518-853-4335.

#### SPRING CLEAN-UP DAYS

Sat. April 27<sup>th</sup> & May 4th, 7 am to noon S Broadway disposal area

- Proof of residency is required.
- One Load Per Household will be accepted. (No larger than a small pickup truck load)
- NO Hazardous Waste will be accepted.
- Regular Household Garbage is NOT accepted.
- Construction Debris is NOT accepted the property owner will require private disposal.
- A disposal fee of \$5 for automotive tires and \$10 for commercial tires will apply for any tires collected.

Large items can be scheduled for pickup during regular work hours (7 am to 2 PM) the week of April 29<sup>th</sup>. Montgomery County, Solid Waste fees will apply for certain items. Please call the Village Office @ 518-853-4335 for costs and to schedule a pickup. There is a limit of ½ pickup truck per household.

**Lead Service Line Inventory** – **The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)** Lead and Copper Rule revisions require all water systems to complete a Lead Service Line inventory

by October 16, 2024. A visual inspection of the line coming to your house/building needs to be done. Please call the office or email to be placed on the appointment list. We will also be coming around to do outside inspections of the service line at the curb valves.

# Spring and Summer Home Maintenance Checklist from your Village Building Code Department

Once the ground has thawed and the trees begin to bud, it's time to prepare your home and property for spring. On top of your regular spring cleaning, you'll also want to consider these general upkeep tips using this spring & summer checklist.

- 1. Clean faucet aerators and showerheads to remove mineral deposits. Repeat in the fall.
- 2. Remove leaves and debris from gutters and downspouts. Careful if doing this on your own.
- 3. Refinish decks and porches.
- 4. Check woodwork for insect holes.
- 5. Inspect roofs for missing, loose, damaged shingles and leaks. Hire a reputable contractor.
- 6. Fix peeling paint. Always check for lead paint.
- 7. Service air conditioning systems and change filters at least once per season.
- 8. Change batteries in smoke detectors or install/replace new detectors if needed. Detectors are required on every floor and every bedroom/sleeping area.
- 9. Install/replace Carbon Monoxide Detectors where required.
- 10. Inspect swimming pool areas and pool equipment. Make sure alarms, gates and ladders are functioning properly. It may save a LIFE.
- 11. Fertilize lawns and prune trees and shrubs.
- 12. Drain/flush hot water heaters. See instructions.
- 13. Inspect and clean lint from dryer vent and pipe.
- 14. Clean refrigerator and freezer coils and empty drip trays. Will run more efficiently and safer.

Do it yourself or hire a professional. If hiring a professional remember to beware of scammers. Support and hire local reputable contractors if possible.
